



Mr. Azam Jamil was the chief guest of the occasion. Azam Jamil is a certified CPD Life Coach and has more than 44 years of experience in Hospitality, Tourism, Management, Marketing, Operations, Peoples Management and Training & Development. Mr. Azam in response to a question of what would you like to share about your family background as your family belonged to a political background to whom various political parties leaders i.e. Jawahar Lal Nehru, Gandhi and such others has shared "I belonged to Gujranwala from my father side. My father's uncle Justice Deen Muhammad was also the first Governor of Sindh after Mr. Muhammad Ali Jinnah better known as Baba-e-Qaum. He was a pure Punjabi to be elected as the Governor of Sindh. I belonged to Hayat Family of Sardar Sikandar Hayat who was then the PM of undivided Punjab. He used to live on Upper Mall at his residence which was later converted to Police Lines. He is also one of the 2 people to be buried in the premises of Badshahi Masjid parallel to Dr. Allama Muhammad Iqbal. I am honored to be a part of such family and all of this goes in vain if while being a part of such family you don't learn anything from them". To another question of what is your personal experience with the legends like Faiz Shb, Habib Jalib shb he said

"Faiz Sahab, Habib Jalib and such others used to visit our house. In those time children were usually mentored by relatives, friends as well as neighbors". Further while sharing the importance of sports he said that in our times it was the responsibility of schools and colleges to nurture students for sports but unfortunately we people have linked it to physical fitness of individuals. "But for me the important thing of sports is that it teaches you to lose. In Pakistan we do not have courage to bear losses". He also shared that "I have seen my mother working hard and then playing sport the of Badminton after finishing off all of her works. Her hard work also motivated me to take up the sports of Tennis in which I later got distinction as the National Doubles Champion". Moreover, while sharing memories of his acting career he said that" I have worked in a Four Part Serial Play "Zaviay" that was a dialogue between Socrates and Aristotle as well as such other dramas but I could not take it further due to my association with the hospitality industry". While sharing an interesting fact, he said that no body might know the fact that the current Prime Minister of Pakistan's Mr. Imran Khan Mother Shaukat Khanum were 3 sisters and all of them gave birth to the captains of Pakistan Cricket Team which include Javed Barki, Majid Khan and Imran Khan

Mikal Jameel while giving his introduction said that he is an engineer by profession and after his engineering he is currently working on a book on Col (R) Sher Khan's climbing life as well as running a small company. The session proceeded with a question of how did you started climbing and from where did you got the inspiration. In response to the question, he said that his father used to work for Serena hotels and he would often go and stay at various Serena hotels in hilly areas along with his father. "My family also owned a house in Murree where we often used to stay and enjoy our summer season. All of these things together inspired me for climbing as well as aroused my love for climbing". In the next stage of the session, Mikal Jameel took the audience along on a journey of the mountains through a PowerPoint presentation titled "Call of the Mountains". The presentation was a compilation of photographs of Mikal's visits to various places for hiking and climbing i.e. Shamshal, Rakaposhi, Base Camp Ultar and others. He

also shared that the climbing is always done in a group of two or more and it takes trust and adventurous passion of friends to join in a climbing/hiking journey. Climbing has also a strong relation with engineering as the process of hooking with the ropes, their combination with safety items is strongly linked. Further sharing about his Climbing company he said that "Luckily we have a bunch of adventurous people here in Islamabad who are crazy enough to learn this art of climbing and I teach them on safety gear and their usage by going to the places physically". My live first show was also by accident when I was invited to the President House of Pakistan by Mr. Feroze Khan Noon on the eve of Shah-e-Afghanistan Zahir Shah's visit with his delegates, where I had to present the "Luddi" which was appreciated a lot by the audience. I have presented Pakistan's Dances in various countries as well as in front of Prince Agha Khan and his whole family. Zulfigar Ali Bhutto also used to value artists a lot. He recognized my talent and provided me opportunities to move ahead. May Allah almighty protect my beloved country Pakistan due to which I have got so much respect and performed in various countries i.e. Paris, Japan, London, Indonesia as well as Thailand, Bangkok in front of royal family, performed solo in China".




Employees of the Month















MOU Signing




Obituary Umer Sharif


R. M. NAEEM

His artwork is about the common people from his surroundings as he develops relationships whereas notion for good and bad, positive and negative manipulated through interpretation. Initially he worked in oils and recently practices in acrylics. He has showcased his artworks both nationally and internationally and various art collectors own his work around the globe. Alhamra Art Museum is among those national places which showcases his paintings 24/7 and also offers an online virtual tour from 2018. He is the recipient of several scholarships and awards including Provincial Best Pinter Award (1991) and Summer Film Festival Award (2014). 
